

# General Blog Requirement Checklist

## Explorations in Music

	A clear title presents the blog, which includes the name of the unit in the title
	A link or embedded video for the song(s) or work(s) featured.
	Title of the song or work (usually in italics), composers, the date it was written or released, and country of origin clearly supplied in the text of the blog post.
	Your personal reaction to the work and the emotions elicited by the music.
	A clearly formatted analysis of several musical elements and how those elements contribute to your personal reaction.
	Support or counterpoint to your opinions is provided from 2 reputable sources. Wikipedia can only be used one time per blog as a source.
	The blog has visual interest. An image or an embedded video is included. Formatting is clear - use headers and paragraphs.
	Double check the assignment instructions and make sure you have included special requirements for the specific assignment.
	Sources are cited below the article in <a href="#">MLA style</a> . All internet sources must include a working hyperlink to the source material.
	Proof-read your blog. Use an online editing tool. Have your computer read the text to you. Your ears may catch mistakes.
	The blog post URL is submitted through Canvas, with a working hyperlink. If your hyperlink isn't working, you will get a zero and will be required to resubmit with a working hyperlink. Late penalties apply. Hint – after submitting, check your hyperlink.
